

WINSLOW BOWLS CLUB COMPETITIONS 2025 ADVICE

Thank you to everyone who has entered this year's competitions.

1. Please ensure that all games are played by the specified date.

It is usual for the individual or team named first on the draw to be responsible to arrange the game, and although this is still the case, please would everyone be proactive to arrange the games and get them played in advance of the specified date – thank you.

If any game is not played on time before the specified date, the winner will probably be determined by the toss of a coin. It will only be in very exceptional circumstances that it will be allowed for a game to be played late.

Please check the fixtures list and avoid dates when games are on, as well as avoid Tuesday and Thursday roll up times. When you have agreed a date and time please draw for a rink number and enter the details of the match in the Club rink diary.

2. The dress code for games is club shirt or a plain white shirt and blues.
3. If any player is forced to withdraw or is unable to fulfil any fixture in time, including the Finals, the player should inform me as soon as possible so that a decision can be made on the next course of action.

Hopefully there will not be any disputes but if there are please refer them to me asap.

4. The completed and signed scorecard should be placed in the changing rooms above the Club rink diary. When the changing rooms are not accessible due to work being carried out, the completed card should be given to me or left at the bar.

In singles matches the first named individual should arrange the marker, who will be responsible for completing the scorecard and getting the individuals to sign the completed card. The result should be updated on the Noticeboard in the changing rooms by the winner.

SINGLES shall be first to 21 shots

2 WOOD SINGLES shall be 21 ends

AUSSIE PAIRS shall be 10 ends

ALL OTHERS shall be 18 ends

A JACK delivered off the rink or short of the minimum length will be returned to the opponent to deliver with the option of moving the mat.
